For all XLRs, Video, and Network cables

1'-3': Green

5': Orange

10': White

15': Purple

25': Yellow

30'-35': Blue

50': Red

75': Red+Orange

100': Red+White

150': Red+Purple

200': Red+Yellow

250': Red+Blue

300+': Red+Red
